

Building with Moodle Basics: Objectives

Week One

Getting started

Participants will:

1. demonstrate their ability to manage their user profile by uploading a profile picture, editing their city and time zone.
2. consider seven key principles of successful interactive learning and write a response to two of the factors.

Labels, pages and books

Participants will:

1. demonstrate the ability to make a label, page and book in Moodle that include, text with different formatting and images.
2. Demonstrate the ability to add a URL link to another webpage into a Moodle course.
3. demonstrate the ability to use the file picker to upload and insert different kinds of files into a Moodle course.

Forums and Video Meetings

Participants will:

1. demonstrate the ability to write and reply to forum posts.
2. build a forum activity in Moodle and monitor responses.
3. participate in a Zoom meeting discussion.

Week Two

H5P Presentations

Participants will:

1. engage in at least three H5P presentation that includes presentation slides and interactive questions.
2. build a H5P presentation that contains formatted text, pictures, a background and three different interactive question activities.

Week Three

Video and narrated PowerPoint

Participants will

1. produce a 30sec-1min long talking head video.
2. produce a narrated PowerPoint with slides and narration and convert to a video file.
3. demonstrate the ability to upload to a video hosting platform like YouTube and then embed video into a Moodle label, page or book.

Week four

Assessment and feedback

Participants will:

1. engage in several short quiz activities that use different question types.
2. build a practice quiz with at least 5 questions of different types.
3. use and build an assignment activity to send and receive files and text comments.
4. use and build a choice poll activity.
5. use and build a feedback activity and download a spreadsheet of the responses.
